Features of Office 365

Office 365 provides students with the most recent versions of Microsoft Office tools, such as Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, and more. It also includes:

- the ability for students to install a desktop version of the Office Productivity Suite at home;
- one Terabyte of cloud-based file storage (OneDrive), so school work can be accessed on any device;
- storage and backup on Canadian servers; and
- a district-based email address for students in Grades 4-7.

Office 365 enriches the learning experience by providing students and teachers the ability to communicate, store files and collaborate on documents and presentations from school or home – all within a secure, Canadian-based online environment.

Digital Citizenship

We remain committed to teaching students good digital citizenship and safe online behaviour. This includes refraining from storing personal information on your OneDrive account or sharing personal information through your Office 365 email account. It is the responsibility of each student to ensure that the use of technology is both appropriate and for educational purposes.
