Starting with The End in Mind

It is no accident that the grade sevens for this year have provided leadership for the school and have learned to support and encourage their fellow students. Starting with the end in mind gives clarity to our goals. Thinking of where we want to be and what we want to do enables us to make plans and accomplish things that matter.

After the grade seven leaving ceremony at the end of June 2018, I met with the grade sixes – the students who are grade sevens this year. We talked about how they would be the grade sevens, take on key areas of leadership for the school, and then be the focus of our grade seven leaving ceremony in June of 2019. For them it seemed a long way away. In September of 2018, the grade seven students, their teachers and I came together. We considered comments from the previous grade sevens about what they had contributed to their friends and the school as well as how their friends had contributed to their lives. Students then reflected and wrote about what they would do for their grade seven year. A few weeks ago, the grade sevens reflected and wrote about this past year - what they had contributed and how others had contributed to them and the school. Across the school, students from kindergarten to grade six wrote about how the grade sevens had contributed to their lives. The pictures and writing from the students from kindergarten to grade six are posted on bulletin boards and in the gym.

Students wrote about how the grade sevens: had included them, stood up for them, comforted them, performed for and entertained them, led them, organized events for them and been positive examples. The grade seven students had planned what they were going to do – it is no accident that it occurred. They acted on the goals they had made at the start of the year.

At our end of the year assemblies, we celebrated how all our students have grown this year. We look forward to hearing of the continued growth of our grade seven students as they go to high school and watch as our Taylor Park students continue to grow as they, with the help and support of staff and parents, plan with the end in mind...
