





Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

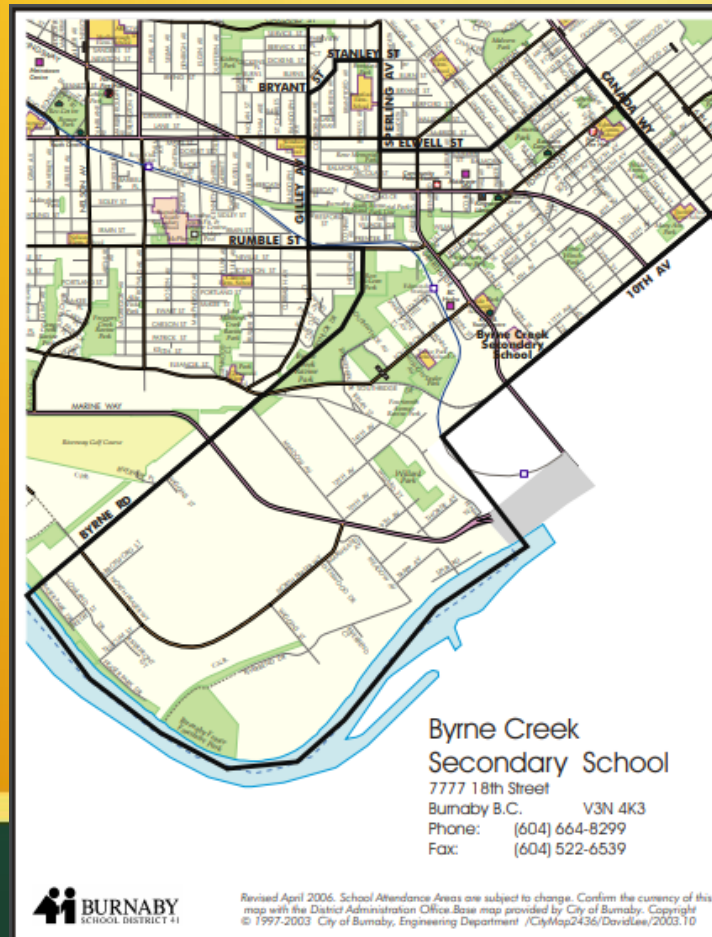
- a. Student address determines your catchment and registration at high school
 - i. Email was sent out in December to update your address
 - ii. Use [the School locator](#) to find your catchment

Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- If your address **is not correct**, please provide updated information to our office as soon as possible. To check for your catchment high school, follow the school locator link at burnabyschools.ca/registration
- Proof of address must include two items, at least one being from **Category A** below:
- **Category A:** proof of ownership of dwelling or long-term lease or rental of dwelling; legal documents indicating BC residence; parent or guardian filing income tax returns as a BC resident
- **Category B:** BC hydro bill, BC cable bill, Provincial driver's license, provincial registration of automobile, Canadian bank accounts or credit cards.

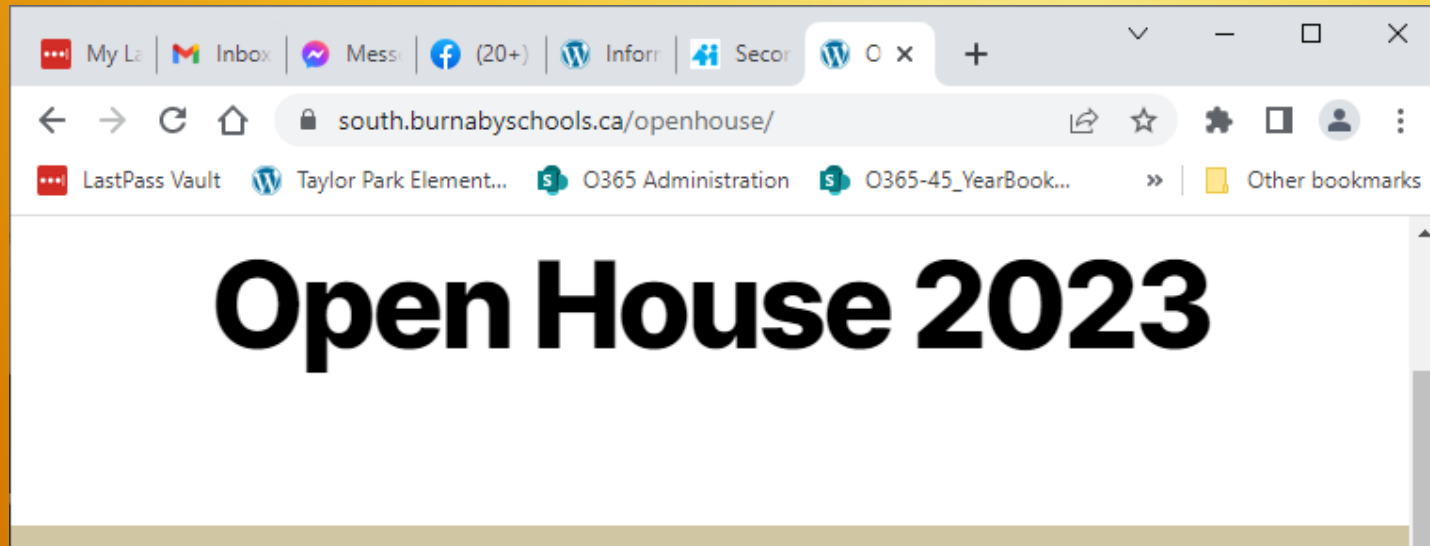


Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- a. Burnaby South Grade Eight [Information Link](#) is online and provided at their information session – both students and parents can attend the event.




Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- Registration for other high schools
 - If you live in Burnaby and are in the catchment of another high school, you will automatically be registered
 - If you live outside of Burnaby or are moving to another address, then you will need to register at that school and meet their registration requirements
 - If you want to go to a school other than your catchment high school, then you need to follow their procedures.



Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- For people living in Burnaby that want to go to a different Burnaby high school than their catchment, a cross-district transfer should be completed and turned in during the month of February
 - For people living outside of Burnaby that want to go to a Burnaby high school, an out of district transfer should be completed
 - For people that want to go to a private school, please check their procedures and inform Taylor Park if you are accepted and plan to attend.

Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight


- Cross District acceptance is based on [board procedures](#)
- The amount of room available after catchment students are placed is the first consideration. All cross-district applications received in February have an equal chance. Applications received between February and June are considered after the February applications.
- Taylor Park would appreciate being cc' d with the cross district request so we can keep track for course selection and transferring student records.

Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- Approval of applicants is based on district priority
 - First, if there is a sibling at the school, second - licensed childcare in the catchment, third - people living in Burnaby, fourth - people living outside of Burnaby
 - If there are more applicants than available spaces, approval is done by draw - the first draw is done approx. mid-March and additional draws take place as space is available. The school you are applying for will contact you. Please inform them and our school office if you accept a placement at another school.



Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- Taylor Park staff can help with course applications for other schools. School orientation and registration information will be sent to you by the high school once you are approved
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Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- There are often misconceptions about high schools:
- The quality of schools – some schools are seen as inferior/superior, because of unofficial ratings – don't be misled
- AP classes and other programs of choice are for grades 10+.
- Some questions to consider are: The distance to the school and how that impacts friendships, group work and participation in school and extra-curricular programs. Are there any specialties/characteristics of the student and school to consider (sports, music, ADST, etc.)?



Articulation – Moving into Grade Eight

- Student support programs such as ELL, Learning Support, Education Assistants should be discussed with the specific school usually after attending their open house.
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
