HipHop – Parents Invited to Watch Our Performances

So far we have less than half of our student cost covered.

Lunar Eclipse

There will be a solar eclipse on Monday April 8. From Burnaby, the sun will only be about 17% covered at maximum. The eclipse will happen from about 10:40 to 12:20, with the maximum around 11:20. The district has sent out information to parents. At this time our plan is for teachers to talk with students about the danger of looking at the sun at any time but especially during an eclipse. The current forecast is for overcast skies so it does not seem, at this point, that people in our area will be able to see the sun or the eclipse. Based on this information, our current plan is to have students go outside for recess at our regular time of 10:30 – 10:45 and go outside for lunch starting at 12:15 pm. Classes can best watch the eclipse online as we do not have safe equipment nor a good view in our location.

Swings

We are excited to be ordering swings for the front of our school. <u>Our PAC is buying four swings and a partner swing for the front of our school</u>. Our swing are just finished being made at the factory and we are hoping for installation in June or July of this year. This will provide an accessible playground for all our students, including those who use wheelchairs. Thanks PAC for supporting this.

Summer Session

Registration for summer session for students currently in grade seven is on Tuesday, April 9th at 10:00 am and for students currently in kindergarten, registration is on Tuesday, April 16th at 10:00 am. Summer session in Burnaby and at Taylor Park is overwhelmingly popular so we highly recommend being ready for registration with your child's PEN number (on their report card) and the course number. Last year, many of our classes at Taylor Park were filled within the first minute and it seemed like the website wasn't working because there were so many people in the process of registration. We will cheerfully ignore requests for specific teachers but carefully consider requests based on your child's learning needs and style. Registration for September 2024 – Cross District Requests Accepted Starting Feb 1

Applications for students who will be starting at Taylor Park begins February 1st. Students currently attending Taylor Park will automatically be re-registered for September 2024. We are welcoming registration of students born in 2019 for September 2024 kindergarten – registration is available online as of February 1st.

Current grade 7 students are automatically enrolled in their catchment high school based on the address we have on record. Further information on high school open houses will be sent out in the coming weeks.

Any grade 7 students wanting to attend a school outside their catchment or any of the cross-district programs, require a cross district application. Please note that cross district forms are due during the month of February – forms sent electronically are preferred. Acceptance into cross district schools for both elementary and high school as well as for special programs (French Immersion, Mandarin Immersion, etc.) is based on school board policy and details are available on the district website.
